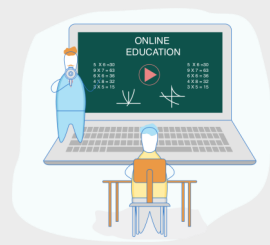
Chromebook Update



We regret to inform you that our Chromebook arrival date has been pushed back once again due to shipping issues surrounding COVID-19. Since our school start date is next Wednesday, August 5th, we need to ensure that all students have access to a device in order to be able to log in to Schoology.

As previously mentioned, Schoology is a web-based learning management system and is compatible with any device that runs updated versions of Chrome, Safari, or Microsoft Edge browsers. Some of these devices include, but not limited to, iPads, iPhones, Android tablets, Android phones, Chromebooks, Windows and Mac computers. If your child does not have access to any of the browsers/devices mentioned above, please email Mr. Oser, our technology coordinator, at aoser@unitedday.org as soon as possible to request further assistance. UDS has a limited number of devices that your child will be able to use until our shipment arrives.

Online Learning Expectations



- Students will be required to log-in on time to each class daily.
- Students may wear any UDS t-shirt to online classes. If your child does not have any UDS t-shirts, school appropriate attire is required.
- Student cameras must be turned on at all times in order to allow teachers to see the students and answer any questions they may have.
- Assignments must be turned in at the end of each class period. Teachers will be available throughout the designated class period to assist students with their work.
- A designated work area at home for online learning is highly recommended for your child.
- School supplies must be readily available at home for your child, allowing them to work on all assignments.



Homeroom Classes for Online Learning

- PP3 through 2nd grade students have been assigned a homeroom teacher.
- All 3rd through 6th grade students will have their respective grade level language arts teacher as their designated homeroom teacher.
- All 7th grade students will have Mrs. Suellen Obregon, science teacher, as their homeroom teacher.
- All 8th grade students will have Ms. Olga Vidal, math teacher, as their homeroom teacher.

Third through eighth grade level homeroom teachers are temporary while online learning is taking place. Once it is safe to return to campus, a survey with learning options will be sent out once again, and you will be able to make your selection of either online or face-to-face instruction. Once these surveys have been completed, homeroom lists for 3rd – 8th grade will be created based on the results.



Class Schedules

The designated subject time is designed for the students to interact with the teacher during his/her live lessons and view the direct teach from the teacher.
